DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

No entries will be accepted by email, phone, or fax. NO HAND DELIVERIES. Express mail entries <u>must</u> include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Lori Brison at <u>loribscentwork@gmail.com</u> No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. However, the club reserves the right to alter this policy due to current events. If the trial is cancelled due to public health guidelines, all checks will be shredded.

Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are eligible for a 50% refund. Owner must provide a note from their veterinarian no later than 24 hours before each trial starts.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of each trial day.

WAITLIST INFORMATION

Hidden Valley Obedience Club of North San Diego County is offering a wait list of a maximum of 30 entries for each trial. These entries are to fill openings created by withdrawn entries before and after the closing date/time. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date. No entries may be withdrawn for a refund after the closing date unless it is replaced by a wait listed entry. Only then will a full refund be issued for the withdrawn entry. Checks will be shredded for full waitlisted entries that do not make it into the trial; partial entries will be refunded.

MOVE-UP INFORMATION

All pre-trial move-ups must be received by Monday, April 12, 2021 at 9pm PDT. The AKC requires move-ups to be in writing. Day to day move-ups will be allowed provided the trial secretary receives your move-up form within 15 minutes after the last class concludes on Saturday. Forms will be provided on trial day.

CONDITIONS AND SEARCH AREAS

Search areas may be of any shape, and size specified in the Regulations for each class. Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, asphalt, and on uneven surfaces. Trial will take place rain or shine.

High in Trial

Novice, Advanced, Excellent and Master High in Trial rosettes will be offered at this trial.

Only teams who participate and qualify in the same difficulty level of all odor elements offered for that level (Container, Exterior, and Buried) are eligible for High in Trial. There is no separate High In Trial for the Novice A and Novice B levels; they are combined. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team will win.

High Combined Division

Novice and Excellent High Combined Division Rosettes will be offered at these trials.

Only teams who participate and qualify in the same difficulty level of <u>all</u> elements offered for that level (**Container**, **Exterior**, **Buried AND Handler Discrimination**) are eligible for High Combined Division. There is no separate HCD for the Novice A and Novice B sections; they are combined. HCD is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times will be summed, and the faster finishing team will win.

Dogs eligible for HCD are not eligible for HIT.

SITE INFORMATION

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area.

The Handler's Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing. The handler's briefing may be modified per AKC Best Practices.

Warm-up area. The club shall designate a warm-up area. One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. This will allow handler-dog teams to prepare themselves for the search prior to their run. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less so that others may also use the warm-up area. Clubs may also place blank containers.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

Spectators are usually encouraged; but will be prohibited due to current events. Exhibitors are forbidden to discuss <u>any</u> details of the searches with handlers who have not run!

Crating: You will be staging from your car. Please park 6 feet apart. HVOC will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. No set ups will be allowed. There will be no overnight security.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Hidden Valley Obedience Club of North San Diego County will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Hidden Valley Obedience Club of North San Diego County reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Hidden Valley Obedience Club of North San Diego County or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

It is NOT appropriate to scout or contact anyone at the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.
